



Athens Tour (Friday or Saturday)

Start from our hotel with our guide and walk through Dionysiou Areopagitou street to visit ACROPOLIS (admire the Propylae, the Temple of Athena Nike, the [Parthenon](#), the Erechtheion with its Porch of Maidens). Continue the expert guided tour with a pleasant short walk passing by the well preserved Herodion and Dionysos Theater, in order to visit the [ACROPOLIS museum](#). With your guide you will avoid and skip the lines of the visitors and go straight in. Main attractions such as votives, artifacts of every day life, statues from archaic period, Caryatids, and of course the Parthenon hall with the metopes, the pediments and the frieze will impress you. Duration of tour 3,5-4 hours 40€/person. Multiple departure times on groups of 20 people.



Excursion to Poseidon Temple at cape Sounio (Sunday)

Our tour starts from our hotel with a wonderful drive along the Athens Riviera. During this relaxing ride you will enjoy splendid views of the Saronic Gulf while passing through some of Athens' most beautiful suburbs, including Hellinikon Olympic complex, Glyfada, Vouliagmeni, and Varkiza. Arriving at [Cape Sounion](#), you will visit the 5th century B.C. Temple of Poseidon with its magnificent panoramic view of the Aegean Sea (on a clear day you can see at least seven islands). Cape Sounion has long played an important part in Greek mythology and history, and the first recorded mention of it occurs in the Odyssey, as the last safe landing before Poseidon scattered the returning Greek navy. As god of the sea, Poseidon was very important for ancient Greeks, and the scale of the Temple at Cape Sounion reflects that. After visiting the Temple, impressed from the beauty, the history and the culture of this site we will drive you to a nice traditional tavern in Vari to have lunch and taste traditional Greek food. After finish your lunch return back to your hotel.

Duration of tour, 4-4,5 hours 60€/person including lunch and wine. Departure at 11.00 am.



Excursion to Delphi (Monday)

Depart from our hotel for one day trip from Athens to Delphi to explore one of the most famous archaeological sites of Greece. Along the way, you will see the plain of Beotia, an agricultural center and also pass by the city of Theva, the birthplace of King Oedipus. You will continue your Delphi day tour towards Mt. Parnassos, making a short rest stop outside the town of Levadia. You will then drive to [DELPHI](#), known in ancient times as the navel of the world. Pass by Castalia Spring, visit at the archaeological site and view the monument of the Argive Kings, the treasury of the Athenians, the Athenian Stoa, the Polygonal Wall, the monument of Platea, the **Temple of Apollo** famous for its oracle and **Delphi museum**, with its spectacular exhibits include the frieze of the Treasury of the Sifnians, the Naxian Sphinx, the Statue of Antinoos, the metopes of the Athenian treasury, the famous bronze Charioteer, originally created to commemorate a victory during the 476 B.C., the Pythian Games, and many other artifacts. After lunch in local tavern, return to Athens via the picturesque mountain village of **Arachova**, built on the south slopes of Parnassus, well known for its attractive hand-woven carpets, rugs and quilts, as well as for its wine and cheese (short stop for coffee). Depart around 15.30 the latest to return at your hotel in Athens.

Full-day tour 80€/person including lunch and wine. Departure at 09.00 am.
